
Meghan Adams, Keating Campaign

Meghan Adams from the Keating Campaign addressed the meeting.

She emphasized that the main goal of the coming Get Out the Vote (GOTV) activities was to turn out the vote by maximizing phoning, canvassing and visibility. We need to get our people out. She reviewed the Combined Campaign Goals. She noted that Democrats have 4000 supporters in Falmouth and we need to bring them all out to vote. There will be 50 canvassing slots for Falmouth. She explained how Hub Dialer works and anyone phoning with that system will be instructed at the office. It is a quick and efficient system which automatically dials through a computer, laptop, Ipad or Iphone to reach a real person. Although the Combined Campaign will provide some

devices to use for Hub Dialing, if you are volunteering to do that, bring your own device. There will also be new literature to give out during canvassing for the Combined Campaign. A sign-up sheet for volunteers was circulated.

Elaine Hickey, FDTC Office Manager, reviewed the volunteer opportunities and explained the concentration of energy to be used from Saturday, Nov. 3rd through election day, the 6th, for the GOTV effort. There will be the usual Democratic party the night of the election at Liam's and all are invited.
